Anti-Pesticide Activist Liz Fox claims to be unsatisfied with the current regulatory decisions concerning pest control products.

Fox uses a report from The Expert Panel on the Integrated Testing of Pesticides, a non-governmental group of academics, to back up her implication that pest control products are poorly regulated.

The Expert Panel on the Integrated Testing of Pesticides is led by DOCTOR LEONARD RITTER, who is Chair Professor Emeritus of Toxicology, School of Environmental Sciences, University of Guelph, and Executive Director, Canadian Network of Toxicology Centres, with 35 years of experience in the field of toxicology and pesticide safety.

During her superficial research, Fox failed to notice that on January 26th, 2012, DOCTOR RITTER defended Canada's system of approving pest control products for the market, by noting that Health Canada's Pesticide Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) is a GOOD SYSTEM THAT IS VERY THOROUGH before it approves any pest control products for use in this country.

Doctor Ritter further commented that ...
