## Discussion use of the word « safe » by PMRA in risk communications for pest control products

Selected and adapted excerpts

The Chair informed Council members of a letter he recently received from a former PMAC member ( Dr. Neil Arya, representative for the Ontario College of Family Physicians ) and provided the background information to the letter.

The letter in question was copied to a few current members of the Council and it relates to the use of the words « safe » and « safely » by PMRA in communications about pesticides.

At a previous PMAC meeting, after discussions about the right way of communicating the safety or safeness of pesticides, PMRA committed to the extent possible to NOT USE « safe » in communications, but it would indicate how pesticides could be safely used.

Dr. Arya, referring to recent media articles, feels that PMRA has used the word « safely » in contravention of what was previously agreed and therefore views this as a change of policy, although not announced as such.

Text of the letter from PMRA Communications Manager to Dr. Neil Arya —

« The PMRA committed to no longer using the term « safe » when referring to registered products following the PMAC request made during the June 6-7, 2005 meeting.

*In general and wherever possible, the term « safe » was replaced with – « acceptable for use » followed by, « when label directions are followed », again, whenever possible.*

*The majority of references to the word « safe » were found on the 2,4-D public page of the PMRA website.*

*The changes were made when this page was updated in time for the release of the 2,4-D Rev Note on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2006.*

*On an ongoing basis, we review the content on the PMRA website and continue making changes to text when the term « safe » is used inappropriately.*

*You will also note that all new public documentation does not include this terminology.*

*In the event a reference has not been changed, please let me know and I will see that it be corrected in a timely fashion. >>*

The Agency made the following remarks to explain its communications approach –

Communications for PMRA should reflect the importance of the RIGOROUS ASSESSMENT DONE FOR EACH PESTICIDE.

PMRA wants to have the ability to inform Canadians about a pesticide, and that a VERY ROBUST ASSESSMENT IS DONE FOR A PRODUCT.

At the same time, much of the assessment relies on proper use by people according to the label directions.

It is important that people understand the conditions of use.

There are no « safe » chemicals, only ways to use them « safely », and that's what PMRA's key messages want to reflect.

The feedback from a PMRA survey shows that people want PLAIN LANGUAGE, for example explaining what is meant by « no unacceptable risk ».

*DESPITE ACTIVIST INTERFERENCE,  
HEALTH CANADA CONCURRED THAT  
PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS  
ARE « ACCEPTABLE », AND  
CAN BE USED « SAFELY »*

The majority of Council members concurs that PMRA should avoid saying that a pesticide product is safe in its communications.


Council recommends that PMRA use the plainest language possible when communicating about conditions for USING PESTICIDES SAFELY.

Furthermore, Council is recommending that in all communications, PMRA should make sure they do not use the word « *safe* » in describing pest control products, and that wherever the terminology such as « *used safely* » or « *deemed acceptable* » appears, it must be linked to a reference to the conditions of use.

While a large proportion of members supported fully this position, it was not unanimous.

A few members support only the use of terms such as « *deemed acceptable* » but not « *used safely* » in PMRA communications.

NOTE — Kapil Khatter was one of the Council Members in the meeting. Khatter was President of Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment, an Environmental-Terror-Organization that CONSPIRED in the Province of Ontario to PROHIBIT pest control products.
