Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration: Re-evaluation of *Bacillus thuringiensis*

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Summary

The purpose of this document is to inform registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated *Bacillus thuringiensis*. The PMRA has determined that *Bacillus thuringiensis* is acceptable for continued registration provided that the proposed mitigation measures (i.e., label statements to protect workers and bystanders) are adopted. Additional data requirements are identified. Upon finalization of the re-evaluation decision, the PMRA will provide registrants of products containing *Bacillus thuringiensis* with specific direction on how to address these measures and requirements.

This Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document provides a rationale for the proposed regulatory decision for *Bacillus thuringiensis*.
