Re-evaluation Decision Document: Dichlobenil

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Summary

The purpose of this Re-evaluation Decision Document (RRD) is to notify registrants, pesticide regulatory officials and the Canadian public that Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the active ingredient dichlobenil and its associated uses as a herbicide in terrestrial non-food areas, on terrestrial food crops and for industrial and domestic vegetation control on non-food sites.

On 25 October 2005, Proposed Acceptability for Continuing Registration document PACR2005-10, *Re-evaluation of Dichlobenil*, was published for consultation. The PMRA did not receive any comments concerning PACR2005-10.

The PMRA has determined that this active ingredient is acceptable for continued registration. Mitigation measures to further protect workers and the environment are specified in PACR2005-10. The registrants have been informed by letter of the specific requirements, including confirmatory data requirements as per Appendix I of this RRD, affecting their product registrations and the regulatory options available to comply with this decision.

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
