Flynn annoyed over committee's approach

Political bias has landed the city's Environmental Management Advisory Committee in at least one councillor's bad books.

While going over minutes from the committee at council's meeting Monday, Coun. Kevin Flynn was first critical of a request that the city reform the Pesticide Select Committee in order to answer questions from the Integrated Pest Management (IPM) industry relating to the city's bylaw. Flynn questioned whether the committee would be the right body to provide answers, noting it did not have representation from the IPM industry or local pesticide retailers.

Coun. Chad Eliason recommended this request be deferred so that the questions could be forwarded to Coun. Debbie Cannon (absent), who chaired the pesticide committee.

What really set Flynn off was a motion from the environment committee that council not receive a presentation from IPM spokesperson John Holland, already provided to the committee, regarding the city's pesticide bylaw.

At first, Flynn went into the committee's minutes, pointing out where they had been amended to criticize Holland's credibility as an advocate of real science. They stated much of what Holland had to say was based on opinion and, "Failure by council to protect the local sensitive environment can only indicate that the mayor and councillors are anti-environment and disregard recent poll results which clearly show that the citizens of Salmon Arm wish environmental conservation to take precedent over development of environmentally sensitive areas."

Flynn remarked: "I would suggest these minutes are approaching a political viewpoint, as opposed to factual information, and I would caution the... committee that if they wish for us to take their recommendations, or myself anyways... with any type of positive approach, they should stop being so political and maybe stick to the facts and stick to the issues and provide their minutes without judging a person's presentation..."

Council's representative on the committee, Ivan Idzan, explained the presentation itself was political in nature, and stretched well beyond council's 20-minute time limit.

"If councillor Flynn is inclined to hear him out, I am sure Mr. Holland and the IPM industry representatives would be thrilled because that's what they've been asking, that council receive Mr. Holland's presentation which, at an hour and five minutes, is rushed," said Idzan.

Coun. Kevin Jamieson agreed the minutes should be more objective, but he also noted how committee volunteers will come with their own passions.

"Any committee that's struck by council, the members are going to come with their own biases and it's impossible to be totally objective," said Jamieson.

Council voted against this committee recommendation, but in favour of another to appoint Sherry Bowlby to the committee. This provided Flynn an opportunity to note a review of the terms of reference for the committee is long overdue.

"I don't want to dissuade the passion, I just want the minutes to reflect a less biased approach."
