

The Wisdom of a REAL Expert Prohibition Is NOT Justified

Health Canada CAREFULLY REVIEWS all scientific evidence and studies before these products can be approved for sale and use in this country.

If history has taught us anything, it's that IMPORTANT DECISIONS SHOULD NEVER BE BASED ON EMOTION.

That's all the more true when it comes to significant public policy decisions made by governments.

Think about the FAILED APPROACH of politicians making a decision based on polling in an effort to boost their own popularity without giving proper thought or consideration to the facts or impact of that decision?

Yet, in a recent letter to the editor, Canadian Cancer Society and Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment [both Prohibition—Terrorist—Organizations] argue for exactly this type of FAILED APPROACH.

They advocate for a province-wide ban of pest control products because some polling suggests that people would support such a move. [?!?!]

Whether that's true or not, surely we can all agree that FACTS AND SCIENCE SHOULD GUIDE THE REGULATION OF PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS.

Utilizing the STRICTEST HEALTH AND SAFETY STANDARDS anywhere in the world, Health Canada CAREFULLY REVIEWS ALL SCIENTIFIC EVIDENCE AND STUDIES before a pest control product may be approved for sale and use.

Recognizing the need to continue to lead in the protection of human health, the federal government REVIEWED AND UPDATED PEST CONTROL PRODUCT LEGISLATION IN 2006, providing Canadians with the STRONGEST PROTECTION on a global scale.

Specifically, PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS UNDERGO MORE THAN 200 SEPARATE TESTS ADDRESSING EVERY POSSIBLE HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUE IMAGINABLE.

VIRTUALLY NO OTHER CONSUMER PRODUCT HAS BEEN SUBJECT TO THE SAME LEVEL OF SCIENTIFIC SCRUTINY AND REGULATORY OVERSIGHT AS PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS.

2,4-D Is Safe

In their letter to the editor, Canadian Cancer Society and Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment [both Prohibition—Terrorist—Organizations] name the most common weed control product 2, 4–D as warranting particular concern.

What they neglect to say is that in May 2008, Health Canada released the findings of an EXTENSIVE REVIEW OF 2,4–D that considered ALL POTENTIAL ENVIRONMENTAL AND HEALTH IMPACTS.

This included special considerations for children, pregnant women, and the elderly.

HEALTH CANADA FOUND NO EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT ALLEGATIONS THAT 2,4-D IS HARMFUL TO OUR HEALTH.

In fact, Health Canada concluded Canadians can continue to use the product and stated —

<< Risks to home-owners and their children from contact with treated lawns and turf ARE NOT OF CONCERN. >>

The exact same position was also taken by regulatory agencies in the European Union, the United States, and the World Health Organization.

Canadian Cancer Society
Misappropriation of Funds?

The Canadian Broadcasting Corporation's television program Marketplace recently analyzed the national Canadian Cancer Society's financial reports going back 12 years.

They discovered that the Society's SPENDING ON RESEARCH HAS DROPPED DRAMATICALLY ...

FROM 40.3 PER CENT IN 2000 TO UNDER 22 PER CENT IN 2011.

Canadian Cancer Society's SPENDING ON ADMINISTRATION AND FUND-RAISING HAS SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASED ...

FROM 26 PER CENT OF ALL MONIES RAISED IN 2000 TO 42.7 PER CENT IN 2011.

While the CBC profile dealt specifically with the national Canadian Cancer Society, the British Columbia and Yukon Division's financial records show a similar trend of DECREASED SPENDING ON RESEARCH ...

DOWN 1.5 MILLION DOLLARS IN 2010 FROM 2005

... with a corresponding INCREASE IN EXPENDITURES ON REVENUE DEVELOPMENT.

Canadian Cancer Society (nationally and provincially) and Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment [both Prohibition—Terrorist—Organizations] are championing causes such as this, and are FOCUSING A LARGE PORTION OF DONORS' FUNDS ON LOBBYING EFFORTS.

Are they using the issue of pest control products TO RAISE THEIR PROFILES AND INCREASE THEIR REVENUES ?

[YES!]

While they are free to make that choice, it doesn't grant them the authority to decide which products consumers may use WITHOUT ANY SCIENTIFIC PROOF OR EVIDENCE.

Health Canada has found PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS TO BE SAFE for use by individuals.

So, THE ABILITY TO EMPLOY PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS SHOULD NOT BE LIMITED BECAUSE OF UNSCIENTIFIC POLLING ARGUMENTS BY ORGANIZATIONS SEEKING TO RAISE MORE MONEY.

Decisions such as these should continue to be made on the basis of SOUND SCIENCE, through THOROUGH RESEARCH AND COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION BY THE SCIENTIFIC PROFESSIONALS we all depend on to keep us safe.

Here are examples of some of Hepworth's wisdom —

- « The weight of scientific research PROVES that pesticides can be SAFELY USED, and Canadians should feel comfortable if they choose to use them. »
- « If the Canadian Cancer Society has information to back up its pesticide claims, it is irresponsibly squandering its efforts on municipal campaigns. »
- « If left unchecked, weeds can DESTROY IMPORTANT GREEN SPACES and other costly infrastructure, and ROB CHILDREN of the opportunity to enjoy ever-so-important outdoor activities. For example, pesticides help ensure students have access to SAFE RECREATIONAL SPACES where they can play without the THREAT OF TRIPPING AND INJURING themselves. »
- « It's a shame that the Ontario government is unwilling to do the hard work of giving due consideration to the many sides of a thorny issue when there is a vocal minority to appease. Such is the case with Ontario's decision to ban pesticide use on lawns and gardens a decision that is both short—sighted and mis—guided. »
- « [The ...] MIS-LEADING CHARACTERIZATION of the Ontario College of Family Physicians' review of pesticide literature is a DISGRACE, although it is typical of activist groups, such as the Canadian Association of Physicians for the Environment, which search far and wide for support of the extreme anti-pesticide position, and yet continue to find themselves unable to point to anything better than the 2004 family physicians' report which is a literature review, not an actual scientific study. »

Alma mater — McGill University — University of Guelph — the first person ever to obtain university degrees and contribute to both the professional lawn care and golf maintenance industries

Expertise in — environmental issues and environmental terrorism — turf and ornamental maintenance and troubleshooting — history of the industry — sales and distribution of seeds, chemicals, fertilizers, and equipment — fertilizer manufacturing

Notable activities — worked in virtually all aspects of the Green Space Industry, including golf, professional lawn care, distribution, environmental compliance, government negotiations, public affairs, and workplace safety — supervisor, consultant, and, programmer for the successful execution of hundreds of thousands of management operations in the golf and urban landscape, as well as millions of pest control applications — advisor, instructor, and trainer for thousands of turf and ornamental managers and technicians — pesticide certification instructor for thousands of industry workers — founder of modern professional lawn care industry — writer for industry publications and e-newsletters — the only true reliable witness who intervened in the development of prohibition in the town of Hudson, Quebec

Special contributions — creator of the exception status that has allowed the golf industry to avoid being subjected to the prohibition o pest control products — creator of the signs that are now used for posting after application — co-founder of annual convention for Quebec golf course superintendents — the major influence for the decision by Canadian Cancer Society to stop selling for profit pesticide treated daffodils — retired founder of Force Of Nature and A Look At e-newsletters

Notable award — man of the year for contributions leading to the successful founding of Quebec professional lawn care industry, which served as a beach-head against activism in the 1980s and 1990s

Legacy — for fifteen years, the strategies designed and implemented by Mr. Gathercole and his colleagues ensured the control of environmental activists, providing peace for the entire modern green space industry across Canada — orchestrated, with his colleagues, legal action against activists in the town of Hudson, Quebec

Mr. Gathercole is now retired, although his name continues to appear as founder of Force Of Nature and A Look At e-newsletters.
