

The variety 'SR-1119' for golf courses.

This variety is adapted for use on golf putting greens, tees, and fairways.

Appearance.

- *Genetic colour.* DARK green. THE COLOUR IS DARKER GREEN THAN MOST BENTGRASSES.
- *Texture.* VERY FINE.
- *Density.* HIGH shoot density — 1400 to 1600 plants per square decimetre.

Maintenance.

- Requires a MODERATE level of nitrogen fertilization. [3 to 5 pounds of nitrogen per 1000 square feet per season.]

Mowing.

- May tolerate mowing heights from 0.100 to 0.150-inch (2½ to 4 mm). The green speed is VERY FAST AT ANY MOWING HEIGHT.

Growth.

- UPRIGHT growth, which provides an ideal lie for the golf ball.

Stress.

- *Heat.* VERY GOOD tolerance.
- *Low temperatures.* VERY GOOD tolerance.

Disease.

- *General.* The overall resistance to disease is GOOD.
- *Brown Patch.* GOOD resistance on greens.
- *Dollar Spot.* GOOD resistance.
- *Fusarium Patch.* GOOD to moderate resistance on fairways, and GOOD to EXCELLENT on greens.
- *Pink Snow Mold.* GOOD resistance.

Other.

- REDUCED tendency to develop thatch.
- GOOD resistance to annual bluegrass invasion.
