

# Sod Quality.

#### Use.

Rush is an improved variety of Kentucky bluegrass. May be suitable for golf course tees, fairways, and rough, as well as sports fields, parks, and nursery sod production.

#### Appearance.

DARK green colour. Delayed spring green-up. Medium leaf texture. HIGH shoot density.

### Mowing.

EXCELLENT tolerance to short mowing. [ 12 millimetres or 0.475-inch.]

#### Growth.

COMPACT growth habit. VIGOROUS seedlings. QUICK germination [7 to 21 days.]

#### Strass.

VERY GOOD tolerance to heat and drought. One of the best drought-tolerant varieties. Moderate tolerance to shade, but sensitive to Powdery Mildew.



#### Disease.

EXCELLENT resistance to Leaf Spot. EXCELLENT resistance to Drechslera Melting-Out. VERY GOOD resistance to Leaf Rust. VERY GOOD resistance to Summer Patch. Sensitive to Powdery Mildew.

#### Thatch.


REDUCED tendency to develop thatch.

#### Other.

VERY GOOD resistance annual bluegrass invasion. This variety resists annual bluegrass better than all other Kentucky bluegrassses. Group « Compact ».
