Gryphon Soccer Complex

The Gryphon Soccer Complex officially opened Tuesday November 8th. The \$7.2 million dollar project comprising two full sized Polytan artificial turf soccer fields, a half sized artificial turf practice field and a full sized natural grass rugby field were completed on time and within the budget this month. This project has been and will continue to be funded by student fees agreed to in the referendum in 2009 and rental revenues generated by community and special event rentals.

Stantec Consulting did the project design work and acted as Project Managers for the project. The design incorporated many "green features" including a large storage cistern to collect rainwater from the artificial turf fields to be used to irrigate the natural turf rugby field, rainwater being diverted directly into the arboretum wetlands and a MUSCO field lighting system that allows for three different lighting levels to be set depending upon use, the most energy efficient system available and one that reduces light spillage to a minimum.

The two full sized soccer pitches were available for play by Gryphon varsity soccer, rugby and lacrosse teams in time for training camps in mid August. Intramural, recreational and club activity began as soon as the students arrived on campus in September. Community groups are booking the fields when not in use by the university programs.

Features of the Gryphon Soccer Complex Include:

Two Artificial Turf Soccer Fields with Lights and Spectator Bleachers (140 on East Field, 400 on West Field)
One Artificial Practice Field without lights (60 metres by 50 metres)
One Natural Grass Field without lights suitable for Rugby, Football, Soccer, and Lacrosse

Varsity Field

Opened in August 2010 Varsity Field replaced the natural grass Rugby Pitch with Polytan Artificial turf. The first artificial turf playing surface in Guelph has played host to Gryphon Varsity Rugby, Lacrosse, Soccer and Field Hockey games and practices, football practices, intramurals and numerous community groups since it opened.
