Quitting a job can be tricky, especially if one needs a steady stream of money after departure.

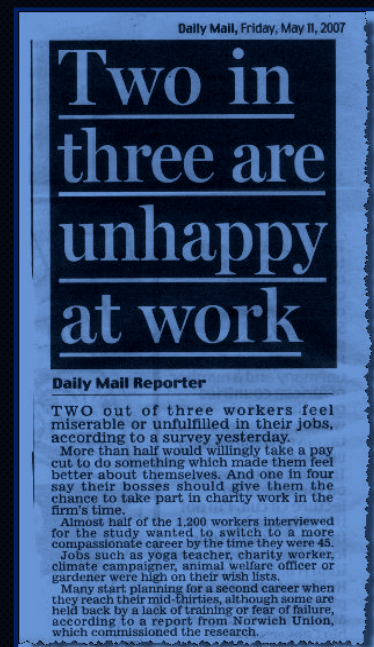
The trick is to quit without losing unemployment benefits, should they become necessary.
