

## Costly implications for a pesticide ban on municipal land

KAMLOOPS — There could be costly implications for the City of Kamloops if council votes in favor of a ban of cosmetic pesticides on all municipal land this week.

A report from the city's Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services department says it would cost approximately \$30,000.00 for additional staff time and alternative methods for weed control.

In addition, the report says \$25,000.00 would be needed for educational purposes for the public including interpretive signage and workshops.

A recommendation by staff is that council approve the two expenditures for the 2016 base budget.

City councilor Arjun Singh, who was among those who voted 5—4 in favor of a pesticide ban on all residential properties in July, says the costs are no surprise.

"We always knew there might be some added costs to being more healthy and how we use our lawn care within the city and I think people expect us to act according to the public bylaw we put in place. If we're going to restrict people's use on their own private property we should do the same within city operations," says Singh.

The report also states it would cost an additional \$40,000.00 for "alternative pesticides, increased staff time, materials and equipment" on sports fields.

The city could also be faced with other costs including \$100,000.00 to replace the turf of a sports field in the event of full infestation.

Staff will vote on the ban at Tuesday's regular council meeting.



## Council weighs options on park pesticide ban

Use of cosmetic pesticides is back on City council's lap Tuesday with a recommendation on extending a residential ban to municipal maintenance.

A two-pronged recommendation would have the City allocate an additional \$30,000 in the 2016 budget for additional maintenance costs as well as \$25,000 for public outreach and education. An accompanying report, however, raises the prospect of significantly greater costs should council decide to extend a park maintenance ban to include playing fields.

## There are three options outlined:

- Elimination of use of all pesticides on ornamental plants, shrubs, and flowers in City parks (\$30,000 cost), as proposed in the July 14, 2015 motion.
- In addition to option 1, include all sports fields and turf areas at an increased cost of \$40,000 (\$70,000 total).
- And/or increase public outreach and education program resources to ensure the long-term success of Bylaw No. 26-2 (\$25,000).

"If council considers eliminating step 4 of the integrated pest management plan in all park (turf and sports fields) areas, the cost of switching to alternative pesticides and management practices would require a further \$40,000 for increased staff time, materials, and equipment," notes Bryron McCorkell, parks and recreation director.

"Other costs could include complete replacement of a sports field turf in the case of full infestation of a playing surface, which could exceed \$100,000 per field."

Substitution of alternatives to RoundUp, including vinegar, heat, steam and various other approaches, is cited as the main reason for increased cost. RoundUp represents a cost-effective operational tool, McCorkell states in the report.

The parks ban would not apply to noxious weeds, which the City is required by law to control, he notes.

After considerable debate and a vocal lobby by commercial applicators, a controversial residential ban passed by a vote of 5-4 in July and takes effect Jan. 1, 2016. Immediately following the adoption of the ban, Coun. Arjun Singh moved that the City should follow suit in its park and grounds maintenance. Singh contends that the City should be leading by example. The matter was tabled until December.

The staff report also responds to council's direction on increased public education on alternatives to pesticide use, which would require expansion of a horticultural outreach program currently offered by the EcoSmart Team. An upgrading of the xeriscape garden on McArthur Island is also part of the tentative plan.
