

# South Vancouver residents up in arms over hungry, messy aphids

Residents in one South Vancouver neighbourhood are fed-up with the smelly, sticky substance that drips from their streets' trees, and some are stinking mad that the city hasn't ended the problem.

Staff say they're doing everything they can to combat the source of the mess, but it's a losing battle they may be unable to win without simply chopping the trees down.

To get a sense of the issue, here's how Joe Coll describes the smell of the dripping substance: "An unholy mixture of rotting garbage, rancid wine, honey and semen."

The problem originates with linden trees — or more specifically, the aphids that are attracted to them. During the summer, those aphids secrete honeydew — a sugary sap — as they feed and reproduce on the linden trees, according to the park board.

The substance is thick and plasters leaves as well as cars, roadways, lawns and sidewalks below. It squelches under a person's rising foot, attracts wasps and at 46th Avenue near Fraser Street, it comes down so heavily that you can see it dripping in the sunlight, Coll said.

The problem lasts months at a time, and while it's not the worst thing that could happen, "it is a major inconvenience," Coll said.

"You get out of your car and sometimes you have it dripping on you and you take the dog for a walk and you look at their paws when they come inside and it's caked with the stuff," he said. "It's gross, really."

Coll is asking city staff to do something — spray the trees with pesticide, release swarms of ladybugs or thin and replace some of the trees with other varieties to reduce their attractiveness to aphids. In fairness, that's pretty much what the city has been doing, as Amit Gandha, a city arborist, explained.

Staff begin by counting the aphids on leaves to find out whether the trees on a given block are infested. If they are, the block will be scheduled for spraying with an insecticidal soap. Incidentally, Coll's block is on that schedule, and Gandha recognized it by name.

The spray chokes the pests and brings their population down, but the trouble is that aphids reproduce regularly and "just when you've done that, there's more," Gandha said.

Another control method is to release "biological-control agents," which in simple terms refer to predatory insects. The city has tried that, too.

"Certain ones we would not release are wasps, because that starts to have other issues like public safety. But ladybugs, we've used them many times. They just don't seem to be able to keep up."

There is another option available after staff have tried everything they could — get rid of the trees.

Nearly 10,000 linden trees were planted in Vancouver in the 1980s and '90s, according to the park board. Since then, about 1,200 of them have been replaced, according to the board. Gandha explained that it takes a bigger conversation involving staff and neighbours before a linden tree can be replaced.

Coll isn't alone on his street in finding fault with the sticky trees.

Nearby resident Ken Mah said he won't park in front of his home in hot weather when the trees are dripping. If he did, he'd have to wash his car every day. Mah has lived on the street for decades — as have many of his neighbours — and he recalled that the large linden tree in front of his home had been planted just over 20 years ago.

"They grow like crazy," he said, noting that the branches hung low to the sidewalk and the leaves were dense enough to block a nearby street light from view.

Mah said he'd like to see the trees replaced with cherry trees as appear on many streets in the city.

Across the street, Mah's neighbour, Jim Eakin, was loading his vehicle. He was parked in an ideal spot — below a variety of tree that didn't attract aphids. He said he likes the linden trees, but not the sticky mess. When asked if he'd prefer the trees were gone, he said it would be nice to have something that wasn't infested, but that he didn't really feel like they should "clearcut the neighbourhood."

For anyone interested in tackling aphids themselves, former Vancouver Sun gardening columnist Steve Whysall had two suggestions: hit them with a heavy stream of water or try to attract predators like ladybugs, lacewings, aphid parasites and aphid midgets.
