READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Causes eye and skin irritation. DO NOT get in eyes or on skin. Avoid contact with clothing. Avoid breathing dust.

Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, waterproof gloves, eye goggles and dust/mist filtering respirator/mask (MSH/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C) or a NIOSH approved respirator/mask with any N-95, R-95, P-95 or HE filter when handling the product and during all clean-up/repair activities. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining personal protective equipment (PPE). If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separate from other laundry.

FIRST AID:

Metarhizium anisopliae strain F52 consists of living microbes. Store closed product in a cool dry place at < 23°C. Unopened product has a viable shelf-life of 12 months from date of manufacture. Exposing product to temperatures up to 35°C will reduce the shelf-life to 1 month. Do not freeze.

DISPOSAL: Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.
