Pesticide Control Bylaw

The <u>Pesticide Control Bylaw</u> regulates and prohibits the application of pesticides for the purpose of maintaining outdoor trees, shrubs, flowers, other ornamental plants and turf on a private parcel or on City owned lands, and applies to:

- residential properties
- town house complexes and manufactured home parks;
- tenants and homeowners
- commercial properties
- industrial properties
- · City owned property

The bylaw does not apply to certain property types, i.e., agricultural lands, forestry and golf courses.

Permitted Pesticides

The <u>Pesticide Control Bylaw</u> contains a sample of permitted environmentally friendly pesticides and we have listed some below. The City encourages residents to research <u>pesticide alternatives</u> to avoid using pesticides altogether.
