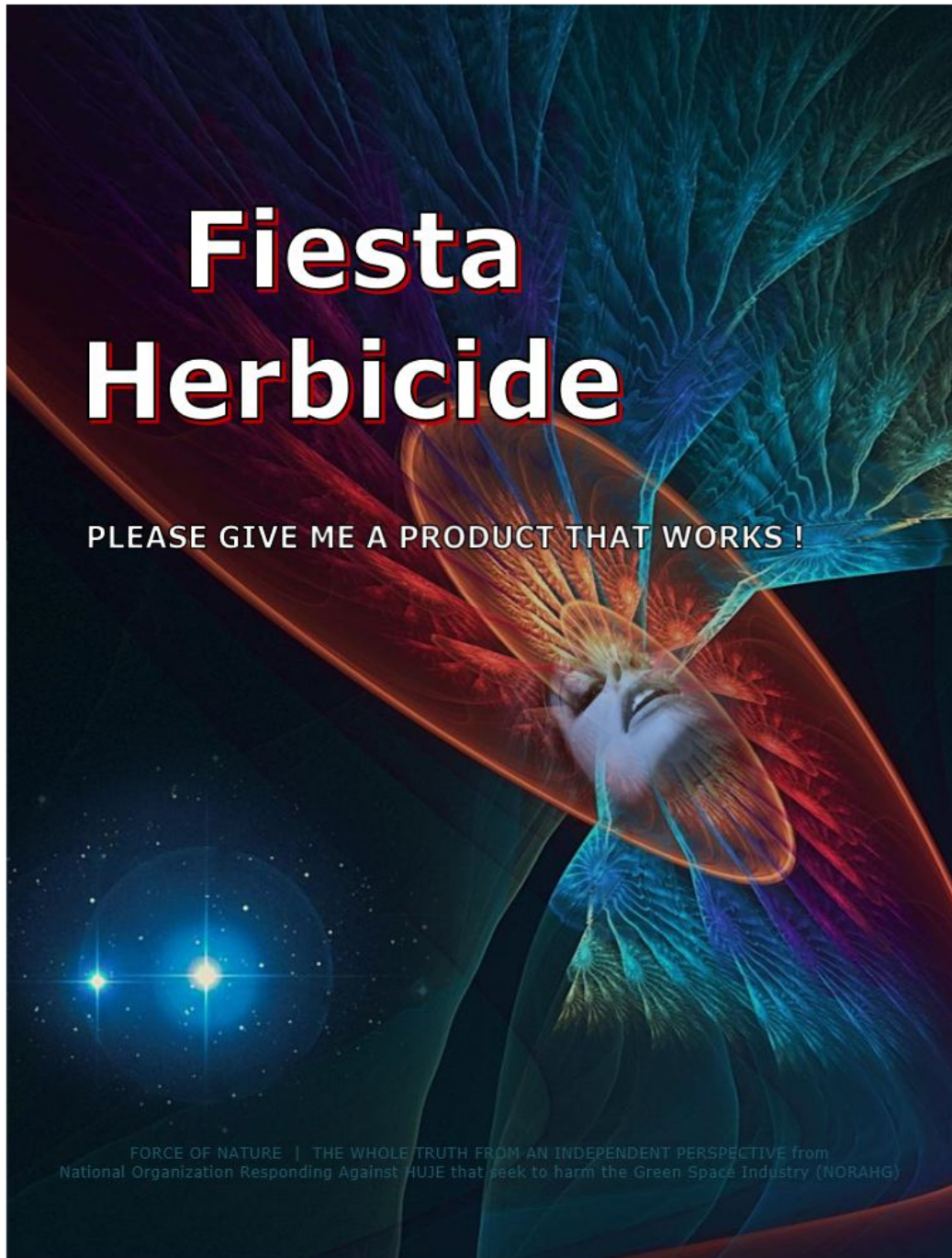

Overview

Fiesta may be ALMOST TOTALLY INEFFECTIVE on many weed species, and may be only SLIGHTLY EFFECTIVE on Dandelion and Black Medick.

Additionally, weed species such as Clover, Broad & Narrow-Leaved Plantain, Chicory, Ground Ivy, Mallow, Oxalis, and Thistle MAY RESPOND TO A FIESTA APPLICATION WITH MINOR DAMAGE ONLY, AND RECOVER RAPIDLY, even when the label rate is DOUBLED.

Adequate broad-leaved weed control with Fiesta Herbicide is too often only achieved with an EXORBITANT 6 TO 8 REPEAT APPLICATIONS PER SEASON, or more, well beyond the label recommendation of 4 APPLICATIONS.

Even with REPEAT APPLICATIONS, the weeds are NEVER ENTIRELY KILLED, and EXCESSIVE USE of iron will lead to a DETERIORATION IN TURF QUALITY AND DENSITY, which will lead to further problems with weed invasion.

General Description Of Fiesta Herbicide

Fiesta is a so-called Green Alternative Pesticide that somehow replaces three-way phenoxy turf herbicides, such as Killex, that contain the active ingredient 2,4-D.

Fiesta contains 4.43 per cent iron (Fe) present as FeHEDTA, a chelated iron.

There appear to be SEVERAL MAJOR NEGATIVES to Fiesta Herbicide when compared with conventional weed control products, such as 2,4-D.

It is NOT a « *natural* » or an « *organic* » product .

As early as 2010, businesses like Nutri-Lawn were releasing statements such as —

Nutri-Lawn, North America's leader in ecology friendly lawn care is very excited to offer its customers the best NATURAL Weed Control product to hit the market since the Ontario-wide ban of pesticides, one year ago.

Fiesta is a NATURAL alternative to the traditional three-way chemical herbicides such as Killex that have been banned in the province of Ontario.

The New Revolutionary, Effective, All NATURAL Guaranteed Weed Control !

Use ORGANIC Herbicides for NATURAL Weed Control.

On such treatment is our FIESTA Weed Control, an ORGANIC herbicide that is child and pet friendly.

Health Canada ordered these businesses to CEASE and DESIST.

Efficacy Of Fiesta Herbicide

STAINING may occur not only by using Fiesta, but also with its agricultural iron equivalents.
