- 2. The Golf Industry MUST ALSO ADOPT THE POLICY that its use of ANY FERTILIZERS DOES NOT HARM THE ENVIRONMENT.
- 3. The Golf Industry MUST OPPOSE ALL FORMS OF PROHIBITION against pest control STEP towards TOTAL PROHIBITION.
- 4. The Golf Industry must DEMAND that ALL PROHIBITIONS pertaining to the use of pest control product in the Urban Landscape BE RESCINDED in ALL PROVINCIAL, STATE, and MUNICIPAL JURISDICTIONS.
- 5. The Golf Industry must also OPPOSE ALL FORMS of PROHIBITION AGAINST FERTILIZ-
- 6. The Golf Industry must TERMINATE ALL RELATIONSHIPS with all Anti-Pesticide Organi-Wildlife Fund, and others. All related charitable tournaments that provide financial donations and support to these Anti-Pesticide Organizations must be SUSPENDED.
- TERMINATE ALL RELATIONSHIPS with all Anti-Pesticide Organizations that conspire to prohibit pest control products, like Canadian Cancer Society. The fund-raising program Golf DOLLARS to organizations that have publicly THREATENED, REPEATEDLY, the Golf Industry with Anti-Pesticide PROHIBITION.

- 8. The Golf Industry MUST CEASE ATTEMPTING TO EDUCATE and TO CONVINCE Antidustry. These Anti-Pesticide TERRORISTS WILL NEVER reverse their attitudes AGAINST pest control products. NO ONE MUST NEGOTIATE WITH TERRORISTS, either environmental
- 9. The Golf Industry MUST CEASE focusing on the INEFFECTIVE practices of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) as the solution to its public affairs problems. Golf Industry trade CONTROL PESTS of established turf and ornamentals.
- 10. The Golf Industry must plan for the INEVITABLE and TOTAL REVOCATION of its EX-CEPTION STATUS in most jurisdictions across Canada. In fact, the BEGINNING OF THE END on golf courses because it's a major industry for PEI and we're working towards getting off
- 11. The Golf Industry MUST ADOPT THE POLICY that the ONLY COURSE OF ACTION AGAINST PROHIBITION IS THROUGH LITIGATION.
- 12. When Anti-Pesticide PROHIBITION is IMPOSED, the Golf Industry MUST LAUNCH LITI-GATION against those Government Officials and Activists who CONSPIRED TO PROHIBIT PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS. These products are, in fact HEALTH-CANADA-APPROVED, FEDERALLY-LEGAL, and PRACTICALLY-NON-TOXIC.

- 25. The Golf Industry MUST TERMINATE ALL RELATIONSHIPS with ALL TEACHING AND RESEARCH INSTITUTIONS that SUPPORT the PROHIBITION of pest control products. ALL joint activities and educational seminars MUST BE ENDED FOR AN INDEFINITE PERIOD OF
- 26. The Golf Industry MUST OPENLY and FINANCIALLY SUPPORT ALL POLITICAL CANDI-DATES WHO OPPOSE ANY PROHIBITION of pest control products.
- 27. The Golf Industry MUST DEMAND that NEW and ADVANCED products continue to be registered in Canada. Under the present circumstances, the Manufacturing Industry will NO LONGER invest in ANY new pest control products in Canada, since it abhors operating in markets made UNSTABLE by TERRORISM, whether political or environmental. The uncertainty created by Anti-Pesticide PROHIBITION means that new products will NOT be brought
