The good news:

The Quebec government is reviewing the Pesticides Management Code and intends to expand the ban to other green spaces beyond lawns.

The bad news:

The revised Code is expected to allow pesticides that Ontario and Nova Scotia have banned.

Disappointing because:

In 2003, Quebec was the first Canadian province to regulate the use of pesticides on lawns. It has since been overtaken by other provinces when it comes to regulating the use of pesticides for cosmetic purposes.
